

COVID-19 Rental Assistance Program



Have you experienced a loss of income as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and are unable to pay rent? INHS may be able to help.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic and its impact on the lives of community members, INHS has worked with funders to establish the COVID-19 Rental Assistance Program. The program is designed to provide rent relief for up to three months to eligible households who have experienced a loss of income related to the public health crisis. You do not have to have been diagnosed with COVID-19 to be eligible.

To be eligible:

- Be a renter in Schuyler, Seneca, Tioga, or Tompkins Counties;
- Meet [income requirements](#);
- Experienced income loss due to COVID-19 pandemic;
- Property must meet condition requirements;
- Obtain approval from your landlord to participate.

Required documents:

- A copy of your current lease;
- Copies of your most recent two months' statements for all bank and/or investment accounts;
- Proof of income loss due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Program Launch Dates:

June 8: Applications begin to be accepted for renters in Schuyler and Seneca Counties.

June 15: Applications begin to be accepted for renters in Tioga and Tompkins Counties.
