

The Scene

Binghamton is located in the Southern Tier Region near the Pennsylvania border, three hours from New York City, three hours from Niagara Falls, three hours from Rochester, and three hours from Philadelphia. Binghamton is the principal city and cultural center of the Binghamton metropolitan area, also known as Greater Binghamton or the Triple Cities. The Greater Binghamton area is home to 152,000 people (according to the 2010 census) and spans over 9 counties; Broome, Tioga, Cortland, Delaware, Chenango, Tompkins, Susquehanna, Bradford, and Wayne.

From the art workshops to the restaurant scene, the Greater Binghamton area gives a variety of local culture that provides a wonderful pace of lively entertainment and growth. Between the festivals and community events, there is always something new to discover.

The First Friday Art Walk, held on the first Friday of each month from 6–9 PM, has been "The Place To Be Gorgeous" in Binghamton, New York. Presented by Gorgeous Washington Street Association, the First Friday Art Walk is our signature event highlighting the area's growing arts community. First Friday patrons enjoy gallery hopping, art openings, music and theater shows, fine dining, cafes, entertainment and merchant's special events at venues ranging from 30–40 locations downtown and throughout the city's neighborhoods.

Serling's career included many other radio and television shows, and he won many Emmy's and Golden Globes for this work. Binghamton High School now has a fine arts program named after Serling, where the students can concentrate in Theater, Visual Arts, Music or Dance.
- A Festival of Spiedies Broome County is known for Spiedies. Spiedies are cubes of chicken, pork, lamb, veal, venison or beef. The meat cubes are marinated overnight or longer, grilled and served on fresh Italian bread or rolls. Every year Spiedies are celebrated at the Spiedie Fest and Balloon Rally. - Ross Park Zoo- Binghamton N.Y. The Binghamton Zoo at Ross Park sits tucked into the northern face of Binghamton's South Mountain. The zoo officially opened in 1875, and it is the fifth oldest zoological institution in the country behind such communities as Philadelphia, Chicago, Cincinnati, and Buffalo.
- Kopernik Observatory and Science Center- Vestal, N.Y. Observatory & Science Center is the first science
 laboratory facility in New York State designed for K-12
 teachers, students and their families. Its mission is to offer
 hands-on investigations using advanced telescopes,
 computers and other tools, encouraging the discovery of
 the wonders of the Universe.
- Binghamton Devils- Binghamton, N.Y. The Binghamton
 Devils are part of the AHL, a 30-team professional ice
 hockey league based in the United States and Canada
 that serves as the primary developmental circuit for the
 National Hockey League. They won the Calder Cup during
 the 2010-2011 season.
- The Rumble Ponies- Binghamton, N.Y. The Rumble Ponies are a U.S. minor league baseball team which plays in the Eastern League. They are the double-A affiliate of the New York Mets major-league club and they won the Eastern League Title during the 2014 season.







Before You Move OUT OF THE AREA

- Sell your current home. We can refer you to a good agent if you don't have one. You may need to
 assign someone power of attorney to close for you. Discuss this with your attorney.
- Get copies of your medical records for all members of the family. Don't forget the specialists that
 you've visited and your dentist. Your new doctors will want this information for reference.
- Move all prescriptions to a national drug store chain, or get new written prescriptions from your current doctor, so you can still get them filled at your new location.
- Get copies of school records for the kids. Inform the school of when you will be leaving.
- Get copies of immunization records for kids.
- Take pictures of all valuables. Preferably video-tape your home prior to the movers showing up.
 This will help with claims later.
- Pack all items that cannot be replaced and bring them with you. Do not leave anything that you
 cannot live without in the hands of the movers. Bring all highly valuable items with you as well as
 the video and pictures of your items.
- If you are packing your items yourself, then make certain you label them with the room and the general contents of each box. This will be really helpful when you are unpacking later.
- Your "Basics Box"--Pack one box that contains the basics and label it as such--put big stars on this box so you can find it easily. The box should include:
 - A ROLL OF PAPER TOWELS
 - A CAN OPENER
 - A ROLL OF TOILET PAPER FOR EACH BATH IN YOUR NEW HOME
 - ONE SET OF SILVERWARE FOR EACH PERSON IN THE HOUSE
 - PAPER PLATES
 - PLASTIC CUPS
 - A SHARP KNIFE
 - A SMALL CUTTING BOARD

- A SCREWDRIVER
- A HAMMER
- A PICTURE HANGING KIT
- A PAIR OF PLIERS
- AN ELECTRIC DRILL
- A BOX CUTTER FOR EACH ADULT IN THE HOUSE
- A DISH TOWEL
- BATH TOWELS FOR EACH PERSON IN THE HOUSE
- A FIRST AID KIT
- Backup your computer and take the backup files with you.
- Have a farewell party to say good-bye to your friends. Provide all your friends with your new contact info.
- Forward your mail to your new location.
- Close bank accounts. Update all automatic deposits and payments with new bank account info.
- File a change of address with the IRS, all investment accounts, insurance agents, and your creditors.
- Inform all groups you volunteer for that you are leaving.
- Give notice to your employer.

When You Arrive AT YOUR NEW DESTINATION



- Get kids set up in new school. Provide school with copies of records.
- Find new doctors and a dentist and give copies of your records to them.
- Meet movers at house. Have them deliver boxes to the rooms they belong in. Put all boxes against the walls so you can still move through the house. Find your basics box and open it immediately—you'll need it.
- Unpack as soon as possible (start with the kitchen--you can live without everything
 else for a while, you will need to be able to make food immediately). Take pictures of
 anything that is damaged and file claims in a timely fashion.
- Set up computer and confirm that it is still operational. Restore files if necessary.
- Set up bank accounts.
- Update insurance to include new home, update files for new address for cars, and adjustments for new personal property. Remember to order additional riders for computers and high-value jewelry and watches.
- Register car(s) in new state.
