



Why Ithaca?

The Scene

Ithaca and Tompkins County are located in the Finger Lakes Region of central New York State, four hours from New York City, three hours from Niagara Falls, two hours from Rochester, and four hours from Philadelphia. The Finger Lakes Region is comprised of 14 counties, which occupy 9,000 square miles, roughly comparable in size to the states of Vermont, New Hampshire, and New Jersey. Ithaca, NY sits at the southern tip of Cayuga Lake, the longest of the Finger Lakes and Home to Cornell University and Ithaca College. The Ithaca area offers the best of small-town life with the cultural qualities of a larger metropolitan city.

Ithaca is the heart of Tompkins County. As of 2019, the U.S. Census Bureau estimates the total population of Tompkins County at 102,180. The county was named in honor of Daniel D. Tompkins, who served as Governor of New York and Vice President of the United States. The climate of Tompkins County provides for a variety of Ithaca attractions and outdoor activities ranging from boating, swimming, and hiking in summer, to cross-country skiing and ice skating in winter. "Ithaca is Gorges" has become the indelible adage that aptly describes the Ithaca area, which has been blessed with deep cut gorges and spectacular waterfalls.





The Culture

For those hesitant about leaving bigger cities due to the possible lack of culture elsewhere, Ithaca has much to offer. The city has many theaters, a civic orchestra, a hands-on science center, and the Museum of the Earth. Home to the Grassroots Festival and Porch Fest, Ithaca has an exceptional music atmosphere with something for every music lover. Ithaca also hosts what is said to be the third largest used book sale in the United States. The city (and local universities) attract people from all walks of life – Tompkins County represents almost all the countries in the world.

Wineries

Wineries are one of the Finger Lakes region's biggest claims to fame! In the heart of the largest acreages of vineyards in the country, you will find award-winning wineries offering tours, tasting, and spectacular views...some of the wineries also have breweries & distilleries.

Real Estate

Ithaca is extremely fortunate to have a strong real estate market, partially due to the strong academic market in our area, and our solid local banks. There are many neighborhoods to choose from and real estate in Ithaca can be quite affordable, though one has to act fast. While there is new construction going on, many of the homes that may be for sale are snapped up quickly. Smaller towns within a 10–20 mile radius of Ithaca are options for anyone looking to move to the area, especially anyone with a desire for an older home. Historic houses are abundant in the area.

Eco-Minded


Ithaca, for those interested in green living, is a very eco-minded city. The city recently joined the Mayors Climate Protection Agreement along with more than 200 other US cities. Between 2008 and 2014, Tompkins County reduced greenhouse gas emissions of county operations by 53% and reduced community greenhouse gas emissions by 21%.



- Cayuga Nature Center Ithaca, NY A non-profit, private organization dedicated to educating the public about the environment.
- Cayuga Waterfront Trail Ithaca, NY Explore the Cayuga Waterfront
 on this 8 mile trail. This trail connects some of the community's most popular
 destinations: Stewart Park, Newman Golf Course, Ithaca Farmers Market,
 Allan Treman State Marine Park, Ithaca Dog Park, Hangar Theatre, Cass
 Park, The Ithaca Children's Garden, etc...
- Children's Garden Ithaca, NY A 3-acre public children's garden designed for kids, but enjoyed by people of all ages.
- Taughannock Falls State Park Ulysses, NY View one of the highest waterfalls on the east coast. Picnic, camp and check out the year-round activities.
- Greek Peak Mountain Resort & Hope Lake Lodge Cortland, NY -Ski in winter and swim any time at this newly expanded resort and water park.
- Fillmore Glen State Park Moravia, NY Photograph beautiful waterfalls, hike one of the many trails, plan a day for a picnic.
- Finger Lakes Trail Ithaca, NY The Finger Lakes Trail system, over 950
 miles in length, runs from the Pennsylvania-New York border in Allegany
 State Park to the Long Path in the Catskill Forest Preserve.
- Montezuma Wildlife Refuge Seneca Falls, NY View an abundance of birds, mammals and reptiles, check out the visitor's center and interpretive programs.
- Robert H. Treman State Park Ithaca, NY Robert H. Treman State
 Park adventure packed wilderness of winding trails. Follow the gorge past 12
 waterfalls, including the 115-foot Lucifer Falls. Camp, Hike, Swim family
 fun!
- Seneca White Deer Geneva, NY Catch a glimpse of one of the only herds of white deer left in existence at the old Seneca Army Depot.
- Watkins Glen State Park Watkins Glen, NY Visit one of the most breathtaking places in the Finger Lakes. Families will love camping, swimming and picnics in the park.

Before You Move OUT OF THE AREA

- Sell your current home. We can refer you to a good agent if you don't have one. You may need to assign
 someone power of attorney to close for you. Discuss this with your attorney.
- Get copies of your medical records for all members of the family. Don't forget the specialists that you've
 visited and your dentist. Your new doctors will want this information for reference.
- Move all prescriptions to a national drug store chain, or get new written prescriptions from your current doctor, so you can still get them filled at your new location.
- · Get copies of school records for the kids. Inform the school of when you will be leaving.
- · Get copies of immunization records for kids.
- Take pictures of all valuables. Preferably video-tape your home prior to the movers showing up. This will help with claims later.
- Pack all items that cannot be replaced and bring them with you. Do not leave anything that you cannot
 live without in the hands of the movers. Bring all highly valuable items with you as well as the video and
 pictures of your items.
- If you are packing your items yourself, then make certain you label them with the room and the general
 contents of each box. This will be really helpful when you are unpacking later.
- Your "Basics Box"--Pack one box that contains the basics and label it as such--put big stars on this box so
 you can find it easily. The box should include:
 - A ROLL OF PAPER TOWELS
 - A CAN OPENER
 - A ROLL OF TOILET PAPER FOR EACH BATH IN YOUR NEW HOME
 - ONE SET OF SILVERWARE FOR EACH PERSON IN THE HOUSE
 - PAPER PLATES
 - PLASTIC CUPS
 - A SHARP KNIFE
 - A SMALL CUTTING BOARD
- Backup your computer and take the backup files with you.
- · Have a farewell party to say good-bye to your friends. Provide all your friends with your new contact info.
- Forward your mail to your new location.
- Close bank accounts. Update all automatic deposits and payments with new bank account info.
- File a change of address with the IRS, all investment accounts, insurance agents, and your creditors.
- Inform all groups you volunteer for that you are leaving.
- Give notice to your employer.

When You Arrive at your new destination



- Apply for a new driver's license (new state) or update your address (same state).
- Get kids set up in new school. Provide school with copies of records.
- Find new doctors and a dentist and give copies of your records to them.
- Meet movers at house. Have them deliver boxes to the rooms they belong in. Put all boxes
 against the walls so you can still move through the house. Find your basics box and open it
 immediately—you'll need it.
- Unpack as soon as possible (start with the kitchen--you can live without everything else for a
 while, you will need to be able to make food immediately). Take pictures of anything that is
 damaged and file claims in a timely fashion.
- Set up computer and confirm that it is still operational. Restore files if necessary.
- Set up bank accounts.
- Update insurance to include new home, update files for new address for cars, and adjustments
 for new personal property. Remember to order additional riders for computers and high-value
 jewelry and watches.
- Register car(s) in new state.


